Total Adults Served

- Counts of Adult Learners having received benefit from AEBG programs and services
- No minimum threshold for instructional contact time
- Tables 1, 2, 4, and 5 are unduplicated headcounts
- Some duplication is likely in Table 3
- Definitions of Student Characteristics / Barriers align to WIA / WIOA

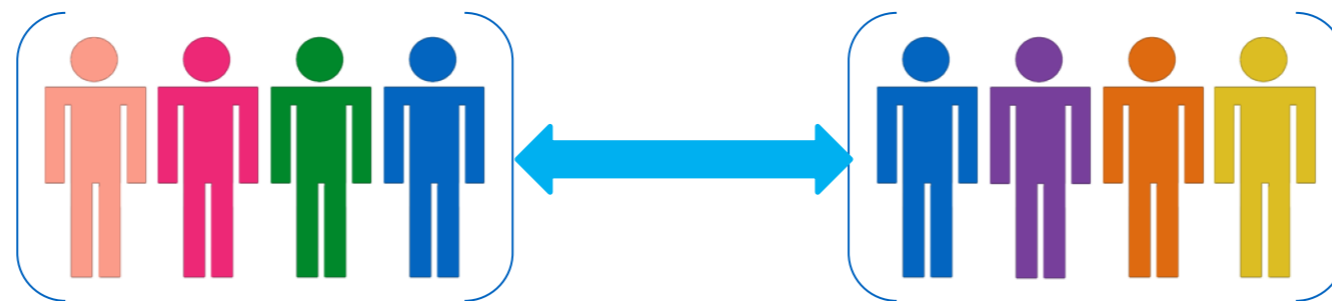
Total Students Served

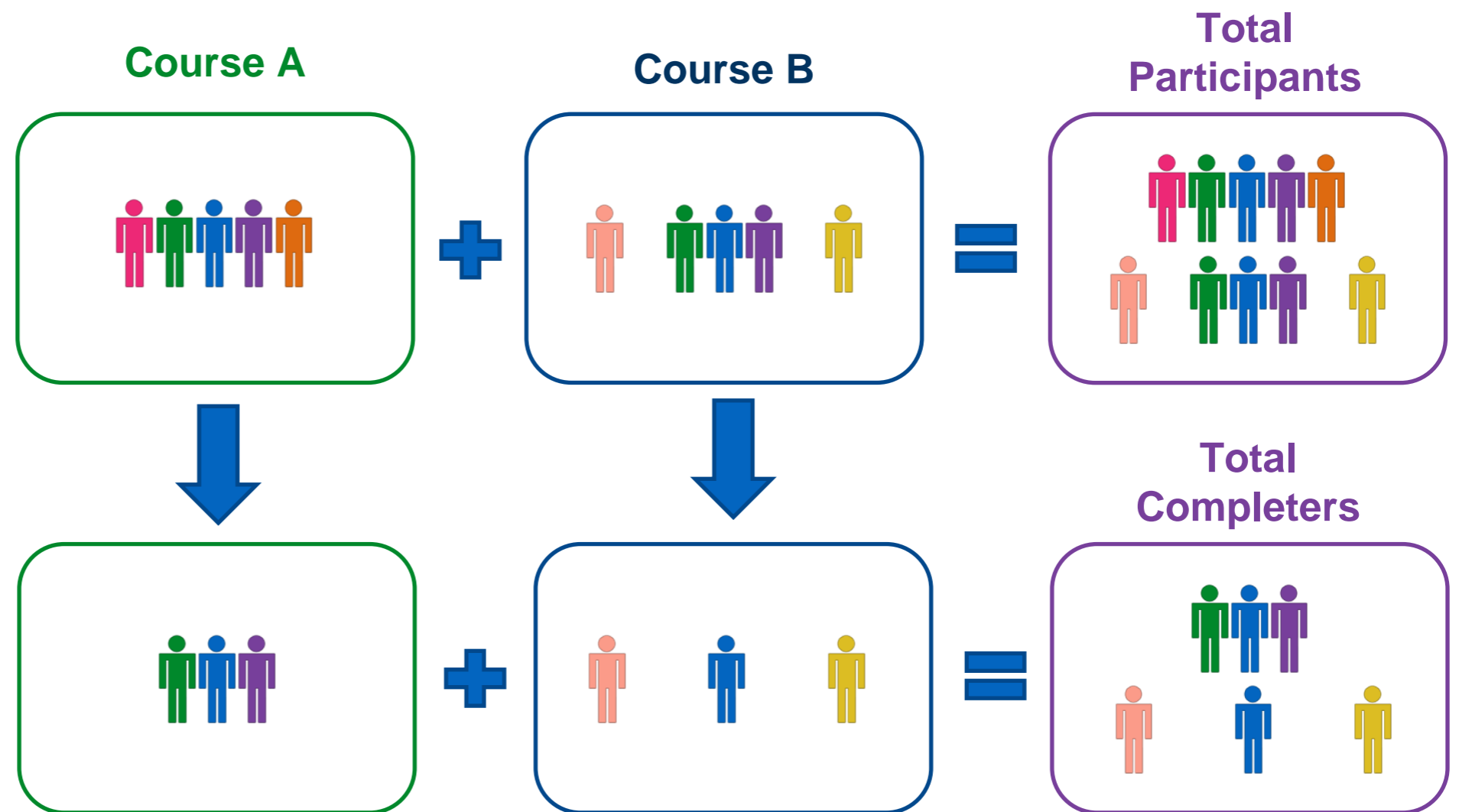
