Adult Education Decision making Procedures Clean-up

- **Section 84905:**

(E) The consortium has considered input provided by pupils, teachers employed by local educational agencies, community college faculty, principals, administrators, classified staff, and the local bargaining units of the school districts and community college districts before it makes a decision.

Adult Education Technical Assistance

- To provide statewide leadership activities for CCDs and LEAs participating in AEBG.
- \$5,000,000 from General Fund.
- One-time funds.
- To Chancellor and Superintendent.
- Chancellor and Superintendent will select:
 - CCD, LEA, COE, or consortium.
- 2016-17, 2017-18, and 2018-19.

Statewide Leadership Activities

Includes but not limited to:

- Develop and disseminate effective practices.
- Provide guidance documents.
- Provide TA to enhance effectiveness of local programs.
- Provide professional development opportunities.
- Provide weekly webinars.
- Establish and maintain internet web site.
- Research effective practices in other states.
- Enhance programmatic collaboration with state and federal education and workforce development programs.

313 Adult Education Apportionments

Section 84905

(2) (e) The members of the consortium may decide to designate a member to serve as the fund administrator to receive and distribute funds from the program.

If a member is chosen to be the fund administrator, the member shall commit to developing a process to apportion funds to each member of the consortium pursuant to the consortium's adult education plan within 45 days of receiving funds appropriated for the program. This process shall not require a consortium member to be funded on a reimbursement basis.

Senate Subcommittee Budget Hearing

Recommendations for Placeholder Trailer Bill Language

- August 1, 2017 Report on options for integrating the adult education assessments into the common assessment system.
- Recommends two-part report – from September 30th, to October 31st and January 1st of each year.
- January 1st report on progress in meeting Ed Code 84920, subdivisions (b) and (e).
 - Agreements, policies, procedures, and data systems planned, developed, or implemented
