## Can Regions Split Consortium?

**Question: Can regions split their consortium down to smaller areas?**

**Answer: Not at this time.**

The original 72 regional planning consortia will stay the same as they were for the planning phase and will continue into the implementation block grant. These 72 existing regional consortia can petition to be combined like a few already did. Note: The budget bill language related to regional boundaries is clear on this - **reference section 84903 of the budget bill** related to the adult education block grant.
